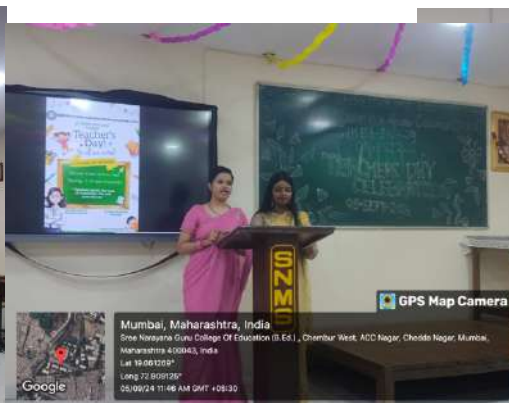

## Greeting Card Making Competition 6<sup>th</sup> September 2024

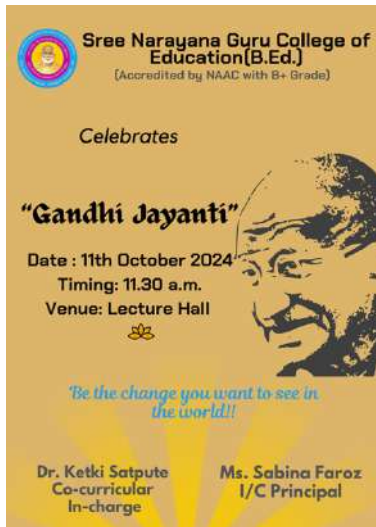

## International Women's Day 8<sup>th</sup> March 2025

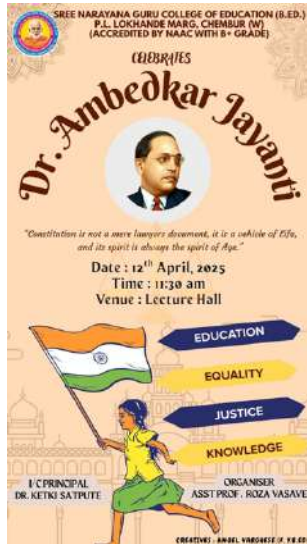
