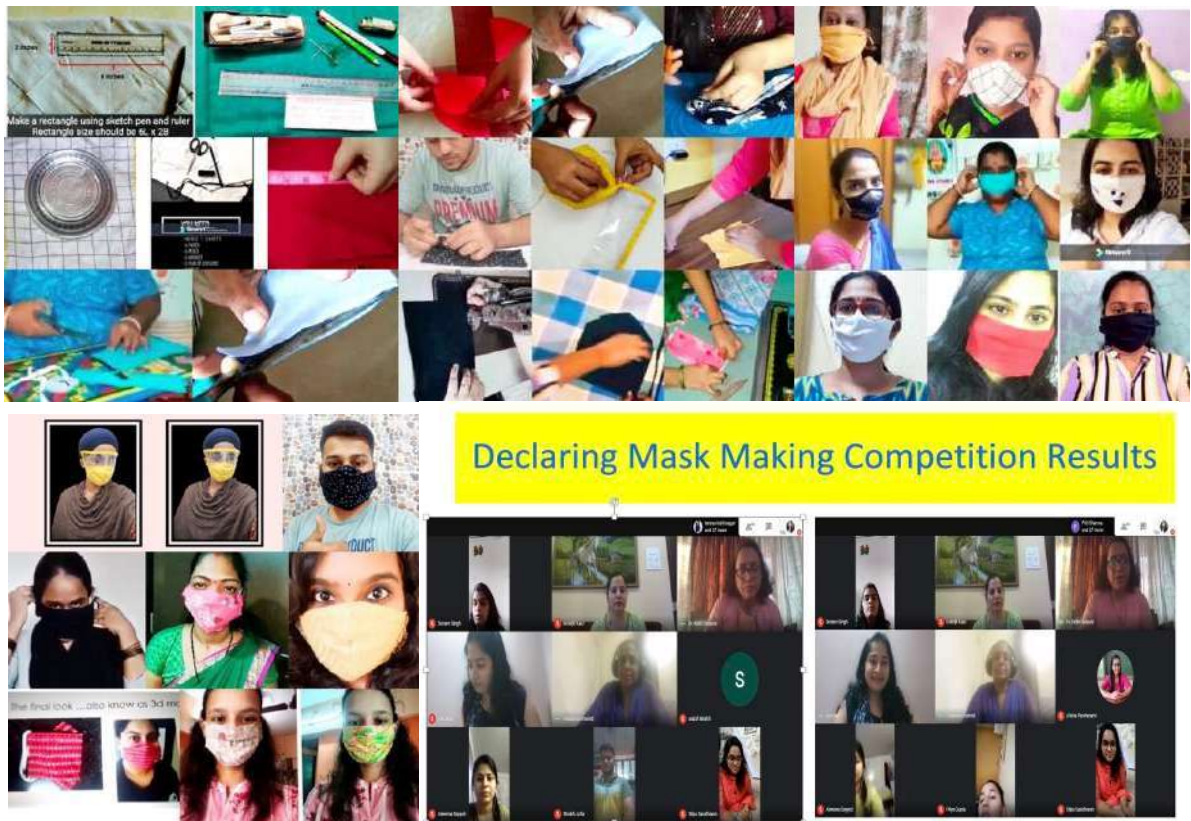


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## **Mask Making Competition 26<sup>th</sup> October 2020**

- \*Only 100 certificates can be issued per day. So if you do not receive e-certificate despite good scores, kindly take up the quiz next day.

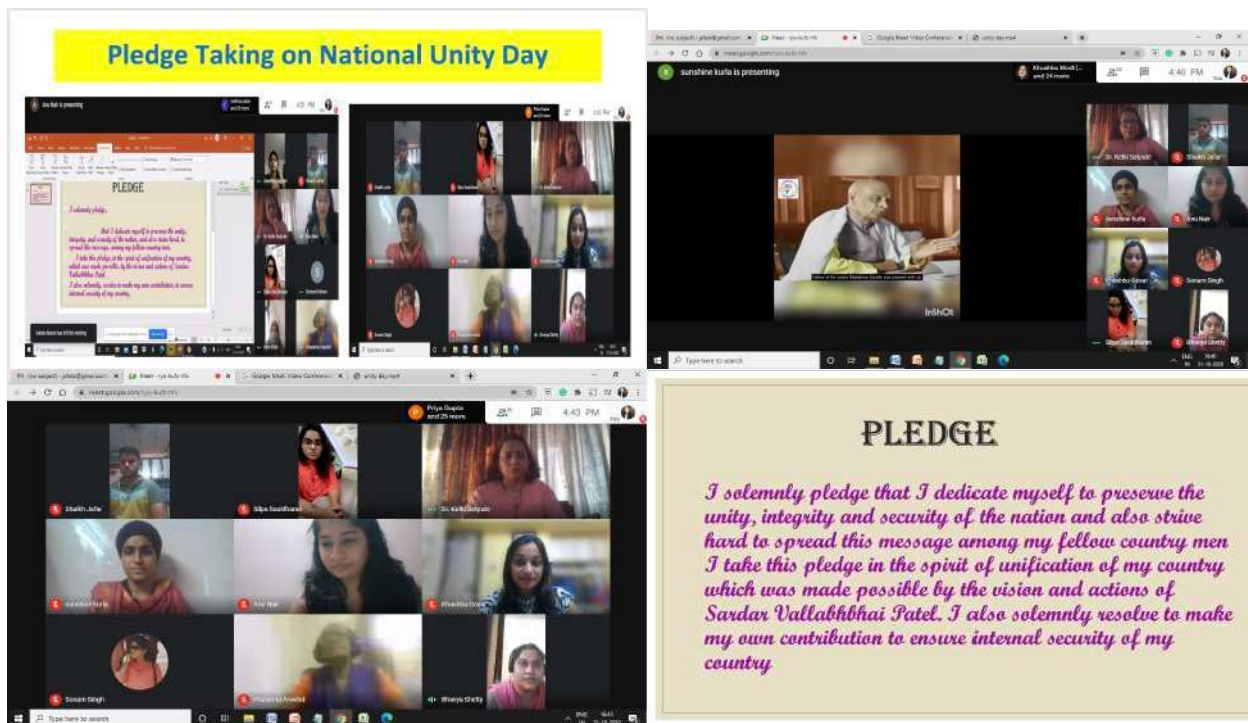


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## **National Unity Day 31<sup>st</sup> October 2020**

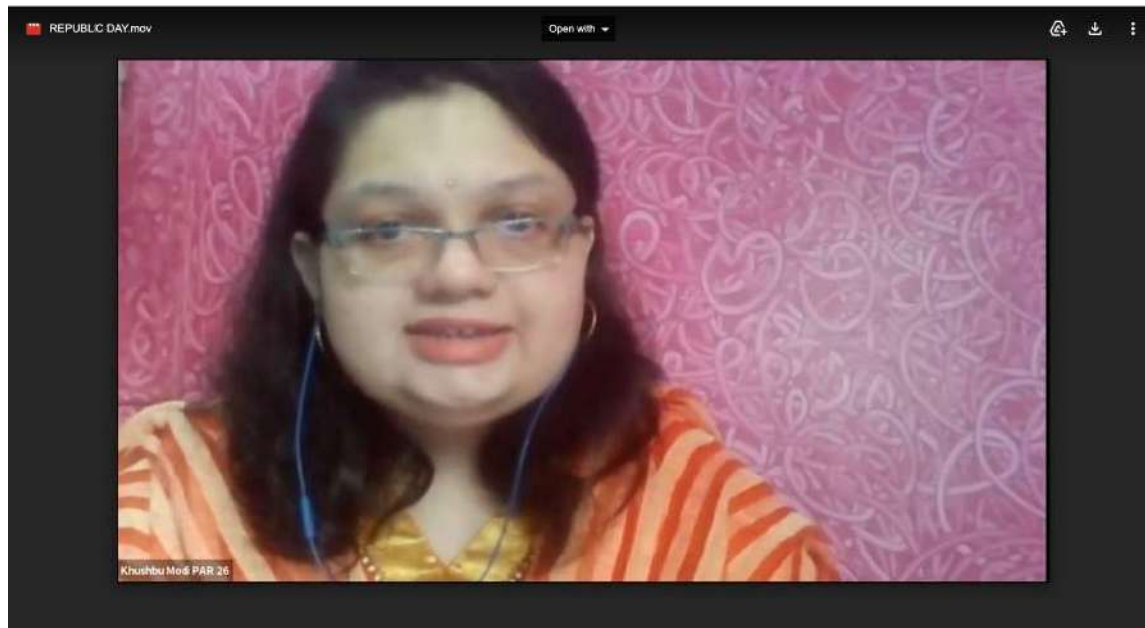
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## **Republic Day 26<sup>th</sup> January 2021**

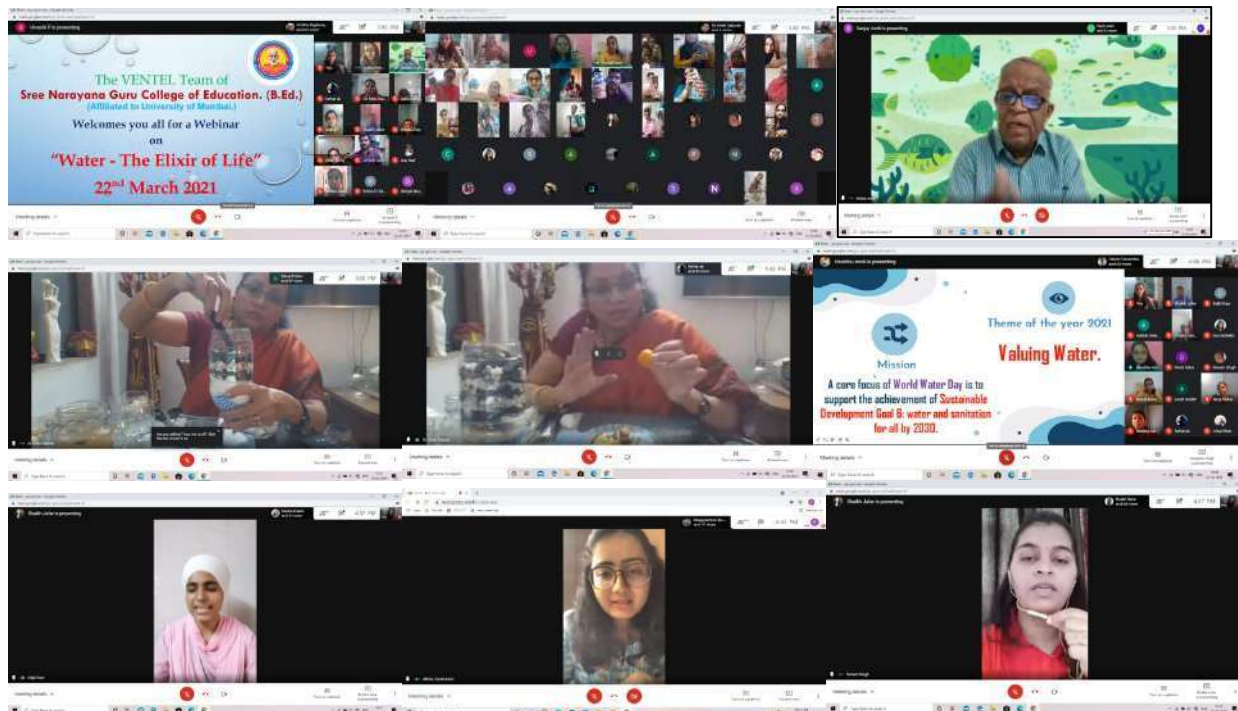


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## **World Water Day 22<sup>nd</sup> March 2021**

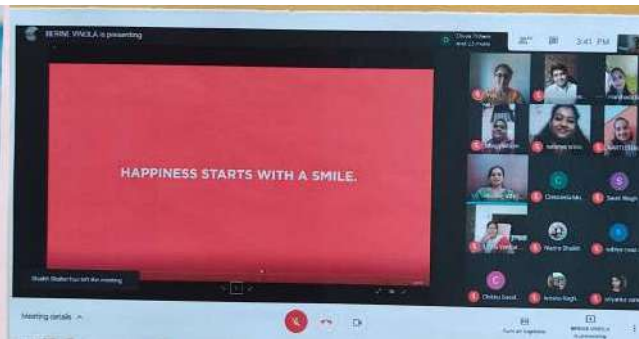
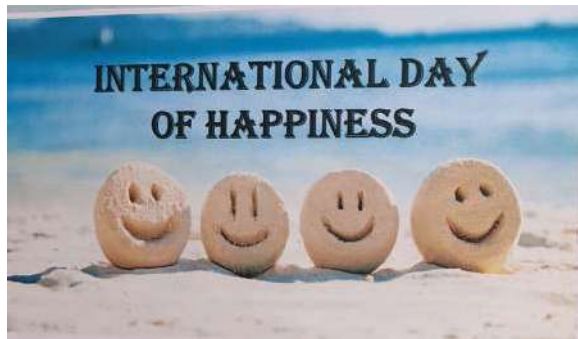
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## **International Day of Happiness 30<sup>th</sup> March 2021**

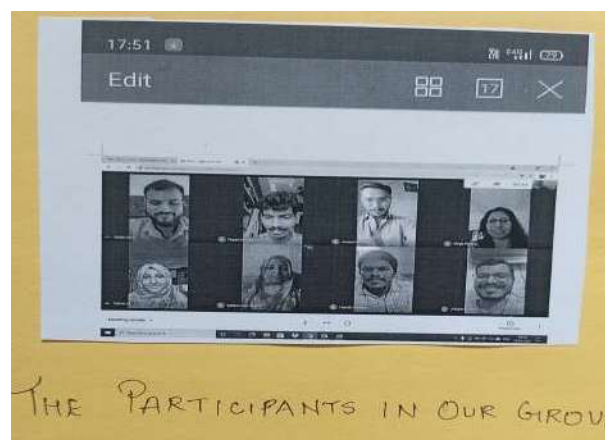
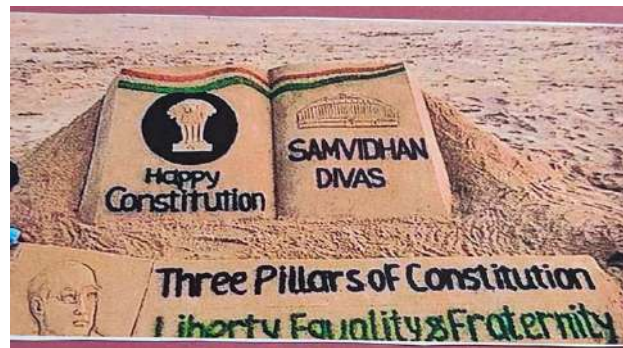


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## **Constitution Day 30<sup>th</sup> March 2021**

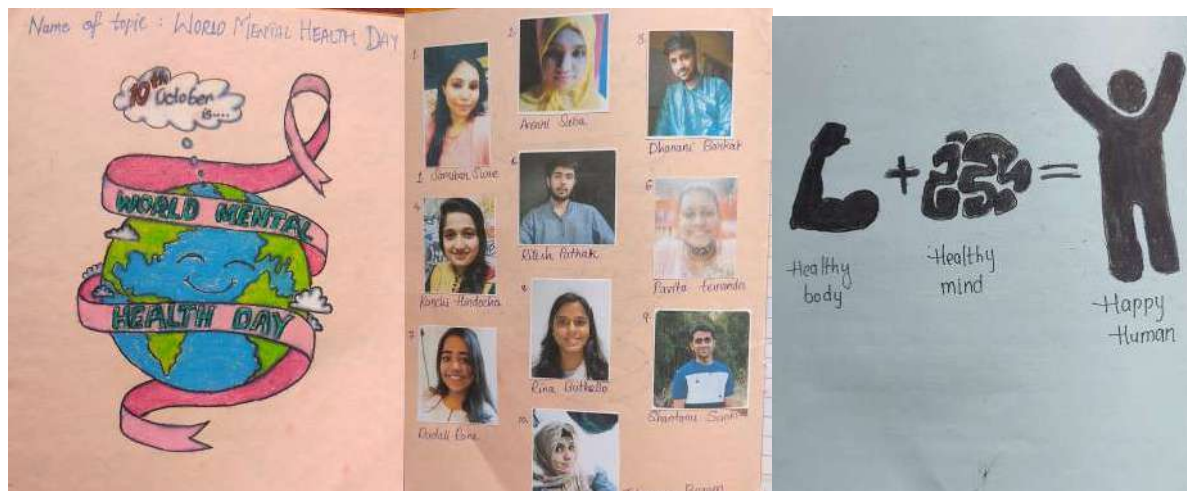


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## **World Mental Health Day 3<sup>rd</sup> April 2021**

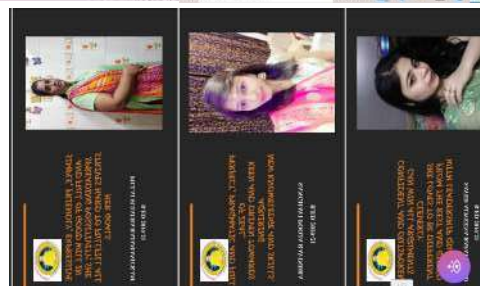
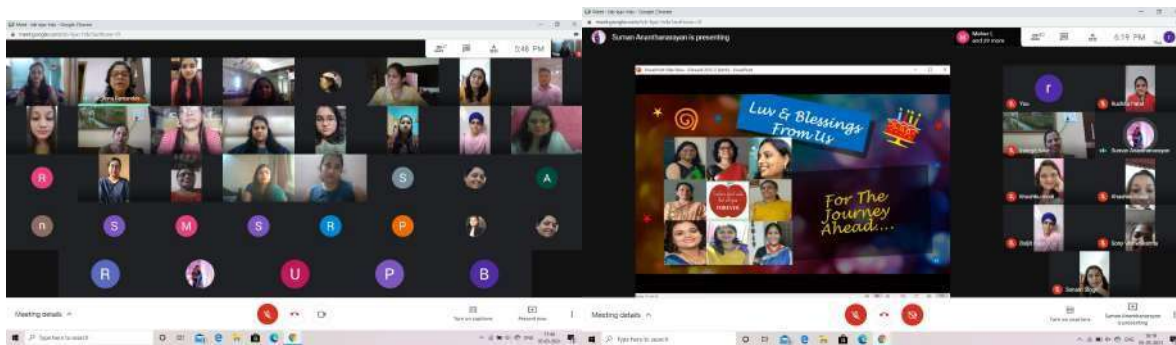


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## **Virtual Farewell Party 5<sup>th</sup> May 2021**
