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REPORTS OF THE CULTURAL EVENTS CONDUCTED DURING THE YEAR 2023-24

Independence Day

15th August 2023

Sree Narayana Mandira Samiti in collaboration with Sree Narayana Guru College of Commerce; Sree Narayana Guru High school ; Sree Narayana Guru Central School; Marathi medium; Pre-primary section and Sree Narayana Guru College of Education, celebrated independence day on 15th August 2023 with enthusiasm. The function started with flag hosting by the SNMS President, Shri M.I. Damodaran. In the celebration various programs were organized such as patriotic songs sung by college and school students; dance performance on patriotic songs by students from various school and college section students ; march pass by school students and many more. 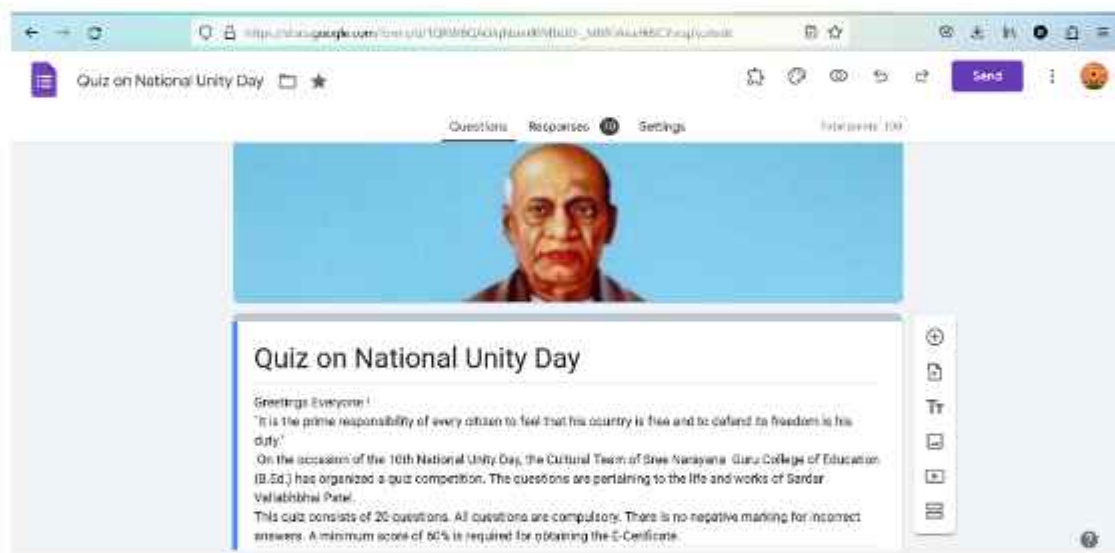


Unity Day Quiz competition 31st October 2023

A quiz was prepared under the guidance of the co-curricular in-charge Dr. Ketki Satpute, using Google Form and the questions were based on the life of Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel.

The objectives behind conducting this quiz are as follows:• To test the knowledge of students about Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel• To incorporate ICT tools to conduct a quiz through online mode• To increase participant's morale by offering them e-certificates.A total 20 multiple choice questions were prepared, carrying 5 points each. The questions were chosen suitable for the cognitive level of B.Ed. students. There was no negative marking for wrong answers. Students obtaining a score of 60% and above were given e-certificates, prepared by Farheen Ansari from the Technical Team. Total participation was 70 students, out of which 61 students obtained the e- certificates, 27 students of F.Y. B.Ed. and 34 students of S.Y. B.Ed.
