

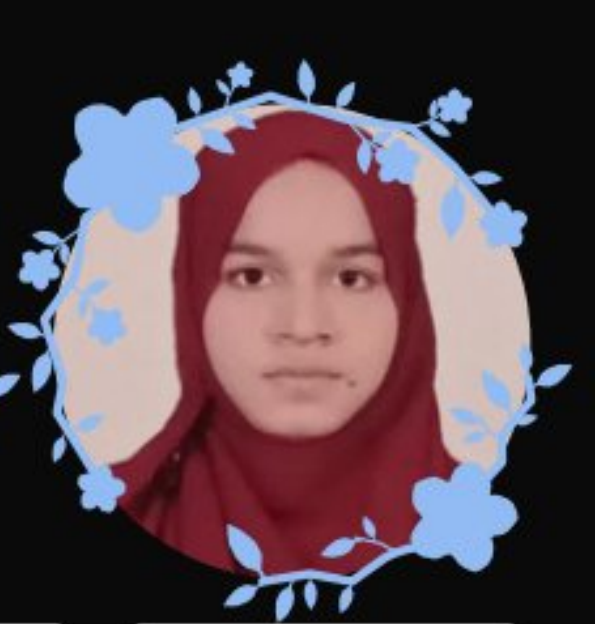

STRESS MANAGEMENT SEMINAR

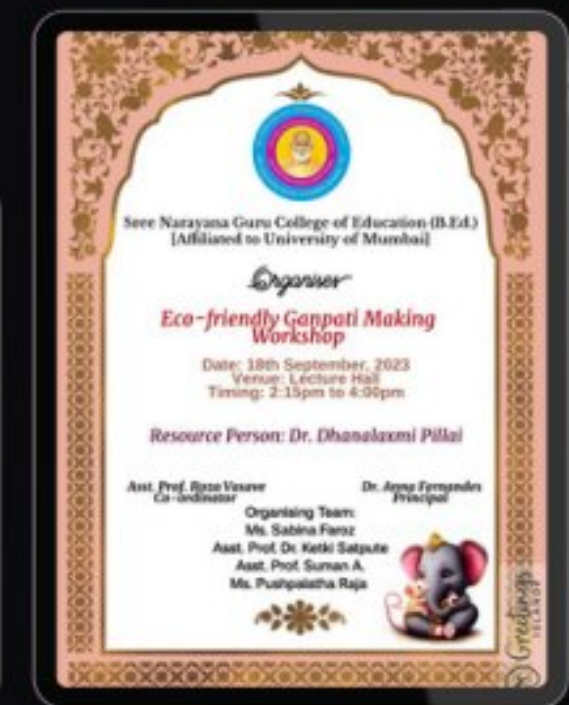

ECO FRIENDLY GANPATI MAKING WORKSHOP

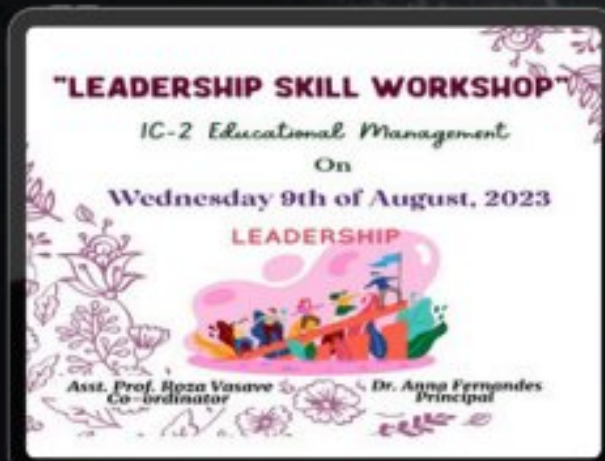


The Eco-Friendly Ganpati Making Workshop, led by Asst. Prof. Roza Vasave on September 18, 2023, promoted sustainable celebrations.

WORKSHOP ON DEVELOPING THE LEADERSHIP SKILLS

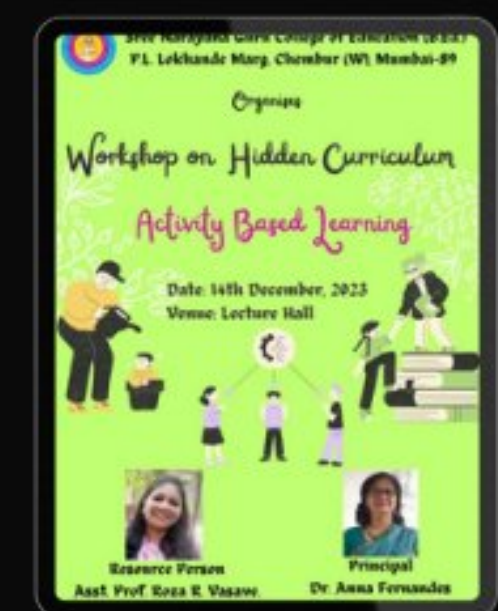

The workshop was well-received, with students expressing gratitude and requesting more such events in the future.

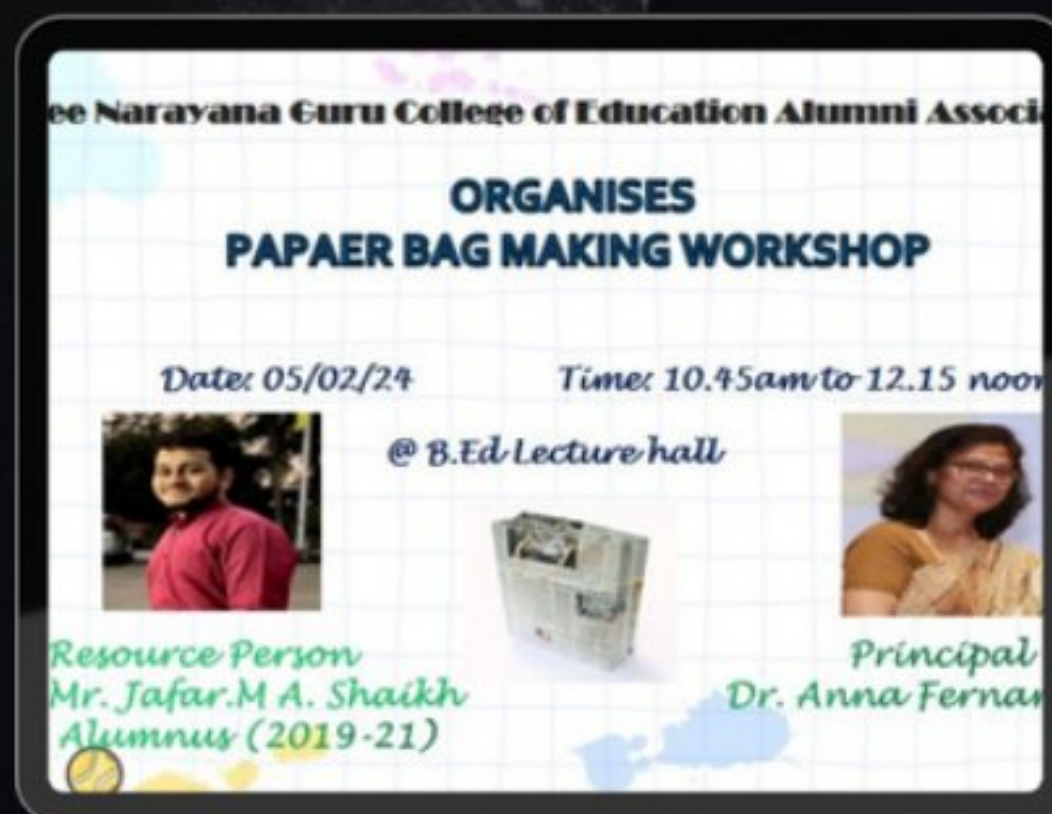
WORKSHOPS / SEMINARS HELD

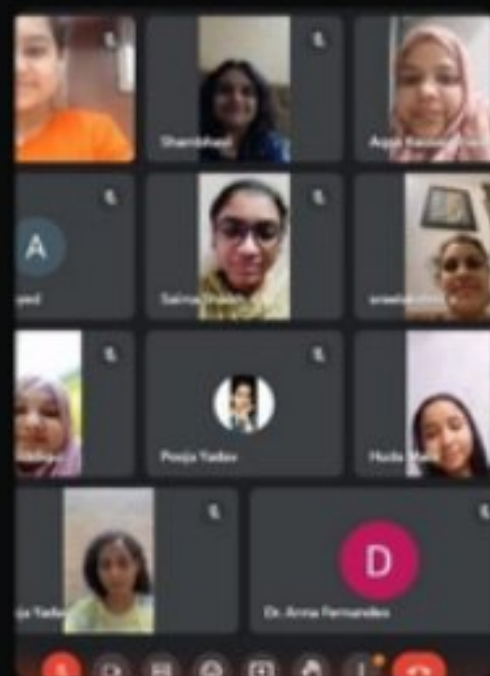
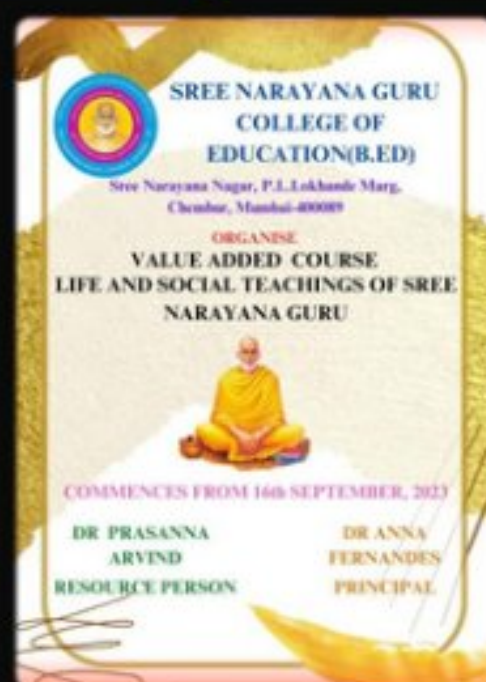

Both sessions were highly informative, offering valuable insights to aid our students in their career planning and professional development.

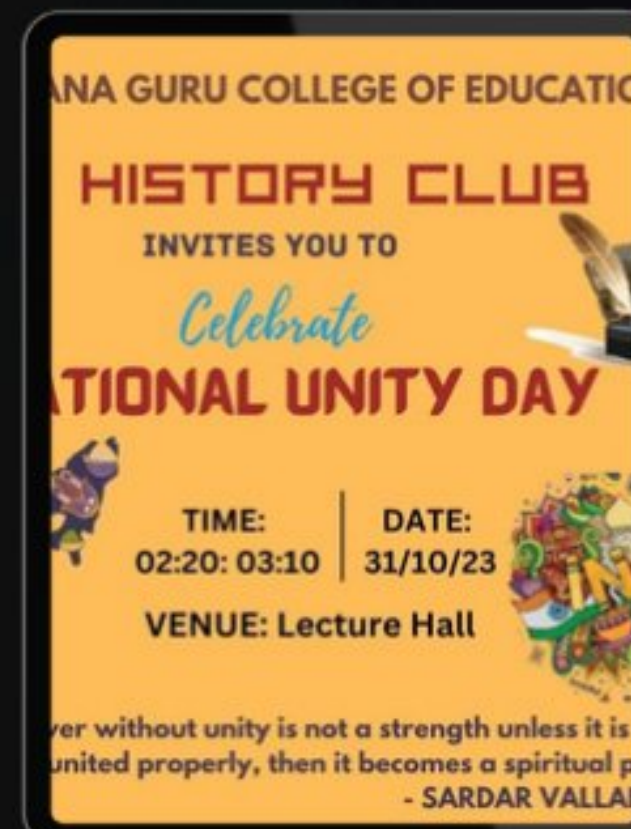

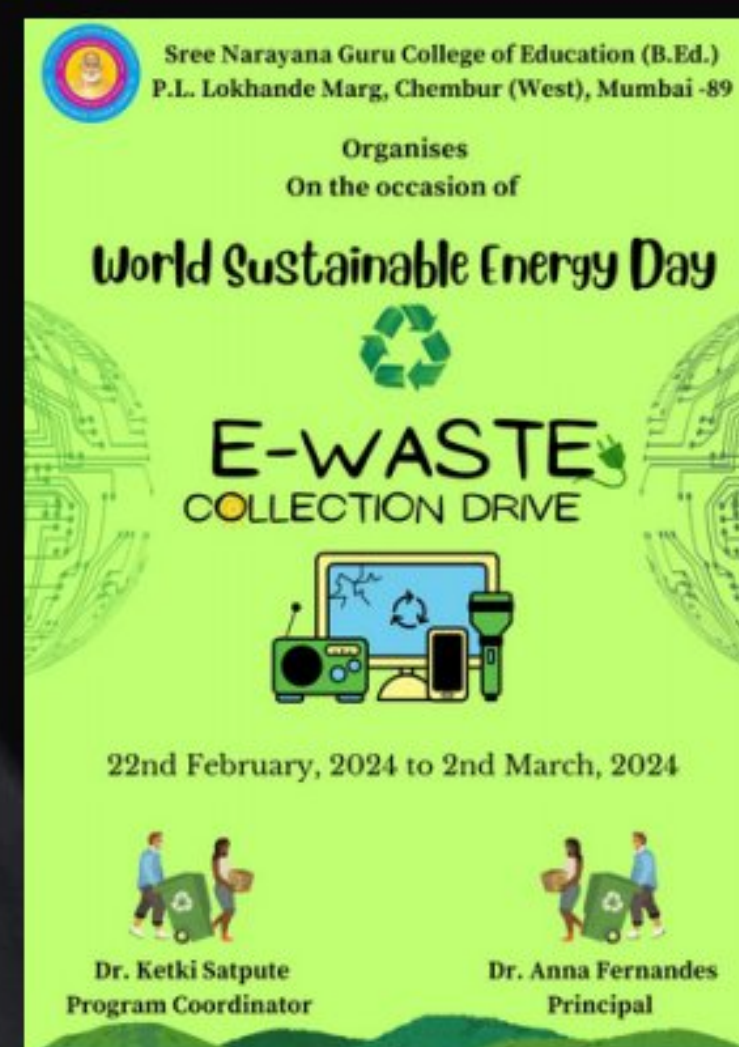
GANDHI JAYANTI CELEBRATION

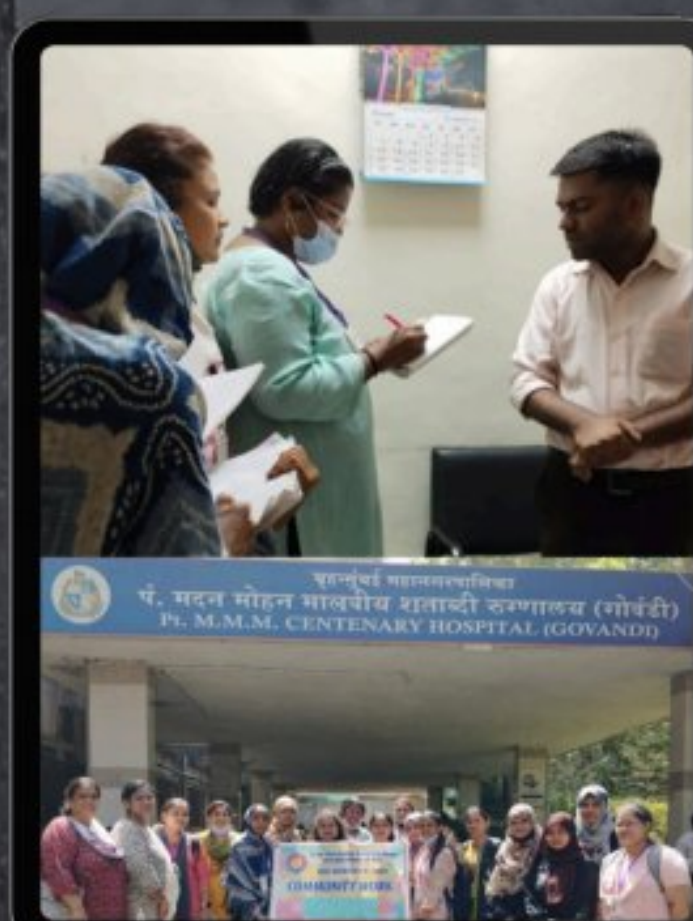

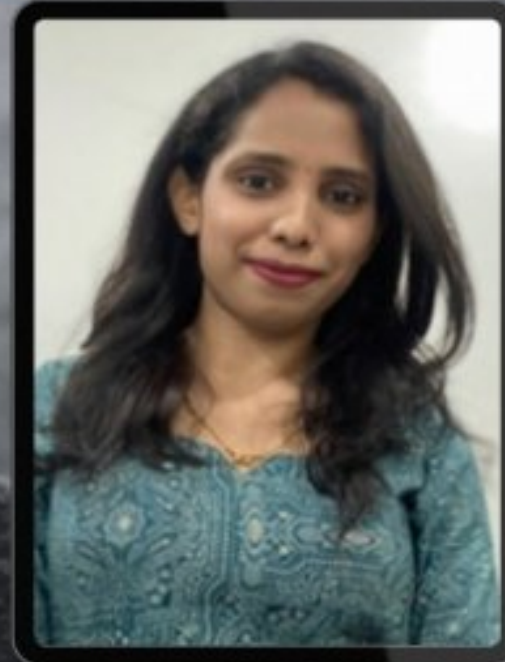

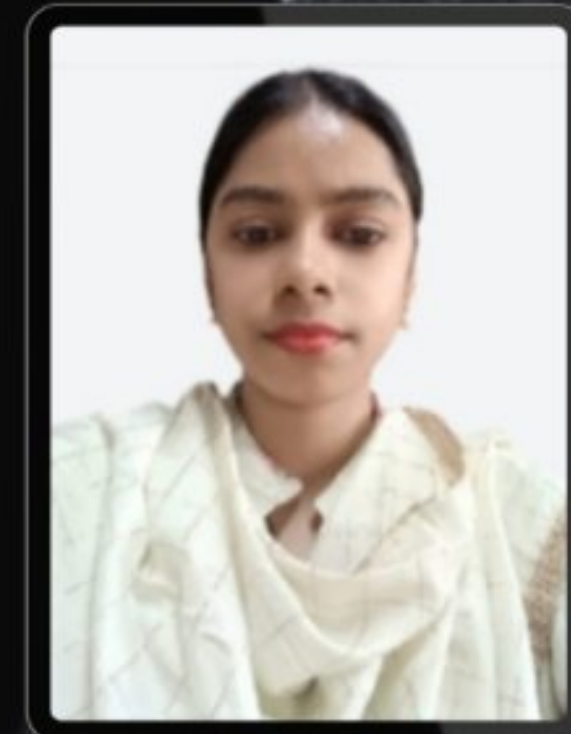

We send emojis, digital cards, and online wishes on important occasions to our friends and loved ones, but we don't dial their number and wish them greetings straight from our heart.

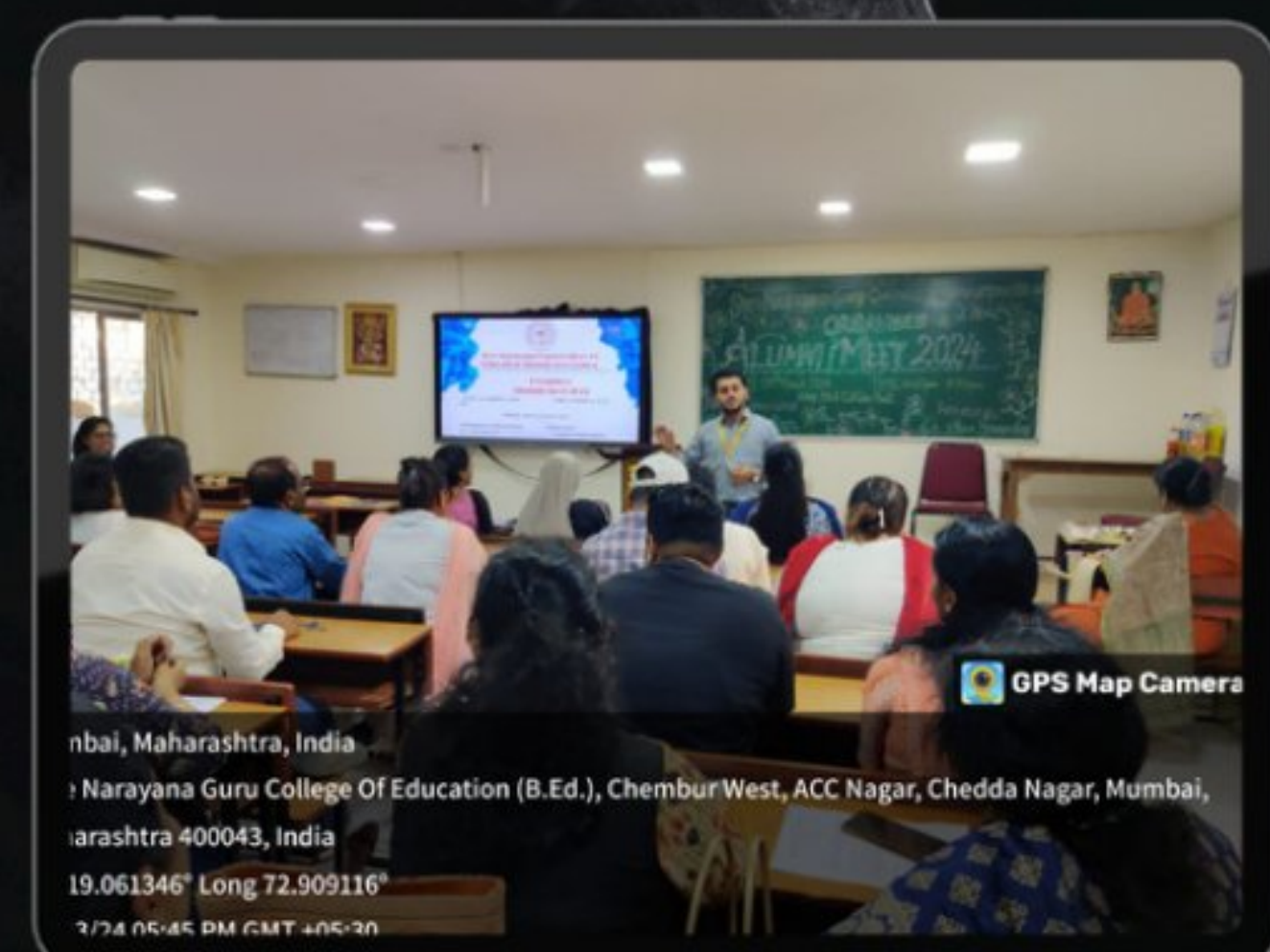

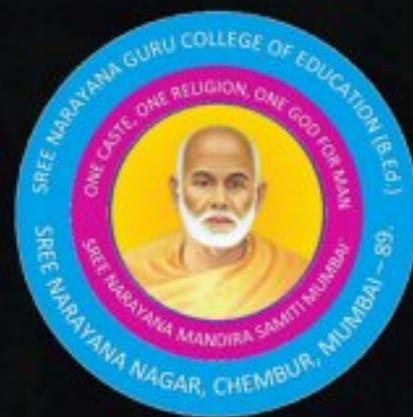
