WOMEN DEVELOPMENT CELL REPORT 2024-25

Women Development Cell of Sree Narayana Guru College of Education organized various programs for the benefit of women throughout the year 2024-25.

1. FILM SCREENING (EK JAGAH APNI): 3rd August 2024

The film screening program was organised by women development cell in the lecture hall for S.Y.B.Ed students. The film "Ek jagah Apni" was shown to the students. Later , WDC coordinator discussed various issues and made students aware that : Transgenders are also a part of this society, they should also get the gender equality in the society. A teacher can create impact on society by making the students aware about the importance of gender equality. The students expressed their thoughts, during the discussion.

2. WORKSHOP ON WOMEN SAFETY AND SCHOLARSHIP: 20th September 2024

As per the circular of University of Mumbai, the Women Development Cell (WDC), Sree Narayana Guru College of Education (B.Ed.)in association with Sree Narayana Guru College of Commerce conducted a workshop on women's safety and scholarship at the college stilt area. Women development cell coordinator Roza ma'am made students aware of Vishaka samiti and its importance. 3. Self Defense Workshop: 23rd October 2024

Shri Narayan Guru College of Education (Women Development cell) and Sree Narayana Guru College of commerce (Women Grievance redressal cell) [Savitribai Phule], In collaboration with Young India Unchained (Prakruti Foundation) organised workshop on self defence.

Mr. Sanjay sir from Prakruti Foundation was the resource person. He started with warm-up activities and took practical sessions during which he showed various self-defence techniques to protect oneself. B.Ed. students as well as Jr. College students of Commerce College participated in this interactive and hands-on session. It was useful for all the girls/women to protect themselves with self-defence techniques in case any untoward situation occurs.

4. Rani Laxmi Bai Jayanti Celebration: 19th November 2024

The program began with Saraswati Vandana, followed by students' presentations on the life story of Rani Laxmi Bai through poetry and songs. Later, a poster-making competition was organized for the students. The theme of the poster-making competition was "Indian women in History."

Students created posters, and the best three posters were selected as winners based on their relevance to the theme.

5. Savitri Bai Phule Jayanti ,(Mahila Mukti Diwas) :3 January 2025

Savitri Bai Phule Jayanti was celebrated on 3rd January 2025. All the teachers and B.Ed. students paid their respects to Savitri Bai Phule by garlanding her portrait. F.Y. B.Ed. students presented a PPT on Savitri Bai Phule's life and her contribution to the development of education and society. S.Y. B.Ed. students enthusiastically performed a street play on the theme "Beti Bachao, Beti Padhao" (Save the Girl Child, Educate the Girl Child) on the playground.

6. World Saree Day: 4th January 2025

The main purpose of celebrating World Saree Day, was to empower women. The program was conducted in seminar hall of the college. It started by lightning of lamp by Wdc coordinator and all the present teachers. The students of S.Y.B.Ed did the prayer. The anchors for the day were Aman and Razi(F.Y.B.Ed), the history and importance of saree was presented by Pooja and Manisha(S.Y.B.Ed) through a short ppt. Then all the students from Fy and Sy did the wonderful rampwalk in saree followed by the rampwalk of all the teachers. The program ended with a vote of thanks. 7. "Standing Against Body Shaming": 11th February 2025

A PPT presentation was shown, which explained what body shaming is, how it affects people (both males and females), and how it can impact mental health. Some preventive measures were also discussed.

The best slogans were selected by the judges, and three winners were chosen. Additionally, three more participants received consolation prizes. The best slogans will be displayed during the Annual Function of the year.
